Vehicle History Report

Key Control Data from SmartKeys

Keys are secured with a SmartKey that includes an identification microchip and a locking ring for enhanced security and functionality. Only users with the appropriate user code, as assigned by their security managers, can access these microchip-tagged keys from the cabinets.
